Clothes catching alight Risk to cubs/adults	1	Adults to closely supervise the cubs. Talk about safety by the fire with cubs before start. Easy exit from camp fire area.	Fire bucket/blanket in reach. Know the procedure to drop and roll.		
Trip/Fall Risk to all	2	Safety chat with all before event. No running near the fire. Revision of code of behaviour expected from all	Adult to tend the fire, not cubs. No throwing of items into the fire. Control the size of the fire so keep it managable
